



Beetroot - Bulls Blood

Beetroot prefers a rich soil, with plant of well rotted compost dug in. Drainage is important.

Use as a baby beet or full size. The leaves are dark purple/red and are ready in around 35 days. The roots mature at around 55 days.

Each seed contains 3 plants, so thinning will be required as plants germinate and grow, to ensure adequate root growth.

Sow every 3-4 weeks to extend your harvest. Water regularly, especially during germination.

Beetroot can be steamed with other veggies, or grated raw, as well as boiled, roasted, or pickled for salads.
