



Carrot - Red Kuroda

To ensure your carrots grown straight and reach their full length, it is important to work the soil thoroughly to at least 30cm deep prior to sewing. Germination is slow so preventing the soil from drying out is important for success. Covering seed rows with shade cloth or cardboard can help. Keep soil moist and do not allow it to dry out and go hard, as this will stop the carrots from breaking the soil. Sew successive plantings in a sunny spot for carrots all year.

This stubby, thick-shouldered favourite yields smooth, uniform tapered roots best harvested 12cm long and 5cm in diameter.

It has a high moisture content, so is suitable for juicing.

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
