



Climbing Bean - Purple King

An outstanding variety of bean, Purple King has long, flat dark purple beans, that turn a deep green when cooked, hence they are sometimes called Magic Beans.

Keep the roots cool by using mulch compost, and water well in dry periods.

Additional fertiliser is not required as legumes will produce their own nitrogen.

Pinch the tips out to encourage a bushy growth.

Regular harvesting will increase yield.

You can eat them straight off the vine, add them to salads, or cook them for just a minute, so that they stay nice and crunchy.
