



Corn Jolly Roger

Jolly Roger produces 1 to 2 medium sized corn cobs per plant.

It needs full sun and protection from strong winds.

Corn is a rapid grower so prepare the soil with plenty of organic fertiliser prior to sowing, and each week during the growing season.

Keep well watered, composted and mulched.

Plant takes between 12 and 14 weeks from sowing to produce ripe cobs. Harvest when the tassel turns dark brown/black. Feel along the cob, and pierce a few grains using your fingernail; if the liquid is creamy the corn is ready to pick.

Delicious and sweet, this variety is best steamed and eaten with a knob of butter.
