



Eggplant - Black Beauty

Plant in a sunny position. Eggplants do not need any fertiliser until you see the first few true leaves. After these appear, apply diluted liquid fertiliser. Keep the soil around your eggplants evenly moist. Every two weeks, apply a fertiliser richer in phosphorous and potassium to encourage flowers and fruiting.

This plant should yield at least 6 large eggplants per plant, with the potential to reach up to 12 in a single season.

Commonly used in stews, sauces, baked, fried, stuffed and grilled. Eggplant is also known as aubergine.
