Florence fennel thrives in warm, sunny and moist conditions. Once your seedlings have been planted out, make sure they are regularly watered. The bulbs will be ready to harvest in about 14 weeks.

Cut the bulb above the soil, but leave the root in the ground. This may re-sprout and produce a second harvest of smaller tender shoots.

This vegetable has a fresh taste with a hint of aniseed and celery. Freshly picked fennel makes a great addition to summer salads and is also delicious cooked as an accompaniment to meat and fish dishes, or on its own.
