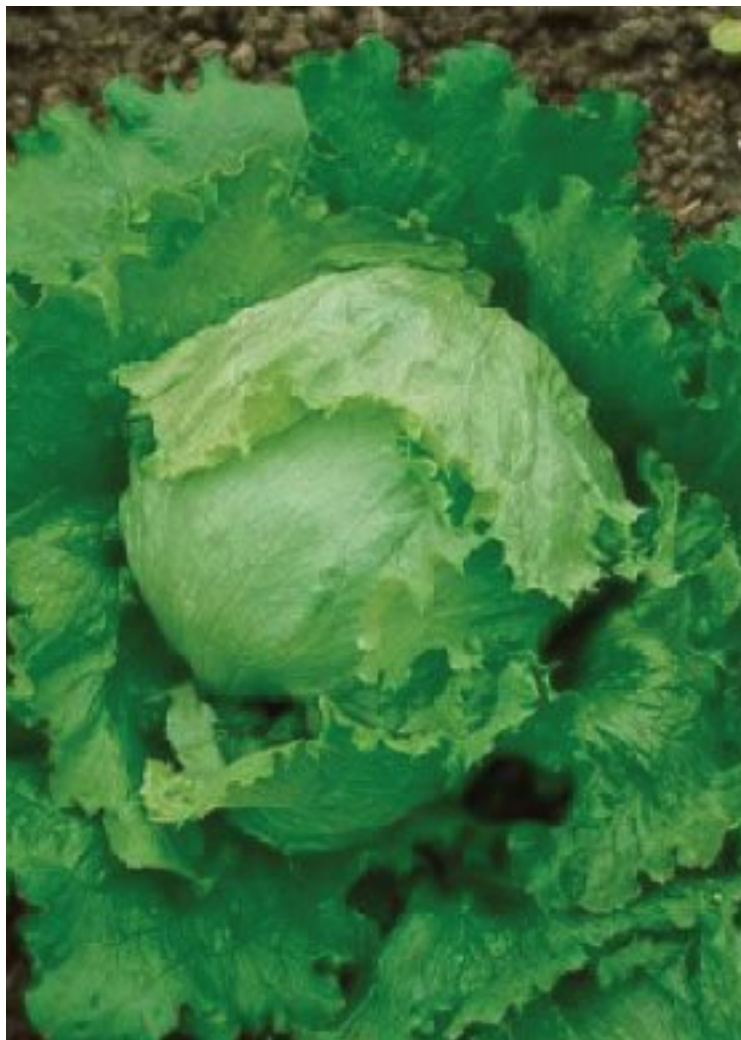




Lettuce - Great Lakes

This is the lettuce to grow for Summer salads. A large, crisp head variety with crinkled leaves which form a dense head in the centre.

The best lettuces are grown fast. Grow them in loose soil with plenty of organic matter to retain moisture.

Added potash will see them grow without check.

Feed with liquid fertiliser every 10-14 days.

Water often as lettuce have shallow roots.

Make successive sowings.

Plant should be ready for harvest 12-13 weeks from sowing.

Great Lakes lettuce have a mild flavour which makes it an excellent variety for shredding and adding to wraps, burgers and sandwiches.
