



Marigold

The flowers of marigolds are edible with a spicy tarragon flavour.

Marigolds require full sun and grow best in well drained, loamy soil. Water established marigolds deeply once per week, allowing the soil to dry out between watering. They benefit from a little fertiliser every couple of weeks.

Remove old flowers as they fade for continued bloom.

At the end of the year, if you want to collect seeds for the next spring, leave a few spent blooms and allow them to fully ripen and dry. Note that the seeds will produce plants that are genetically different from the parents.
