



Nectarine

Deciduous tree that will grow up to 4m tall. Its long, glossy green leaves will turn yellow and drop in Autumn, and dense clusters of rosy pink flowers are produced in Spring.

Plant in full sun, in well drained soil enriched with plenty of organic matter.

Feed young tree with a complete fertiliser balanced for fruiting trees in Autumn and Spring. Water regularly until well established. Once the tree starts producing fruit, fertilise in Winter, Spring and Summer.

In Winter, remove branches to help open the canopy, creating a V shape. Once established, prune to maintain the open shape, removing any diseased or dead wood.
