



Parsley - Giant of Italy

A continental parsley with large, flat leaves that can be used in salads, soups, stews and sauces.

In the garden, this plant attracts beneficial insects such as butterflies. It is a good companion plant for tomatoes and asparagus.

Parsley grows in full sun. Soil should be moist, fertile and well drained. Water plants as needed to keep the soil consistently moist, but never soggy. Feed the plants with a water soluble fertiliser once or twice through the growing season. Snip leaves as needed, or when the plants begin to look shaggy.
