



Parsley - Triple Curl

Parsley does best when planted in a sunny location but can tolerate some light shade. It prefers well drained soil with a high level of organic material to produce good lush leaves.

Plants like to be moist, so try not to let the soil dry out completely. Fertilise with a high nitrogen fertiliser mid season to keep the leaves beautiful and green.

Leaves can be harvested as soon as it reaches about 15cm. Snip each leaf close to the ground to encourage more growth and take no more than about one third of the plant at a time.

It is a great, versatile herb that goes well in sauces, soups, stews, salads and as a garnish. It is best to chop parsley just before you need to use it.
