



Pea (Onward)

Pea Onward is a very popular variety that delivers a prolific crop. The knee-high, bush plants produce heavy yields of pods packed with sweet, tasty peas. The plant gets to a height of 60cm and produces 6-8 peas per pod.

Plant between June and September in full sun in a well drained, fertilised soil. Add lime if soil is too acidic. Dig in well rotted animal manure several centimetres thick. Keep an even level of moisture once plants start to mature, but try to keep the foliage as dry as possible to avoid powdery mildew. Harvest the pods every 2 to 3 days to stimulate greater production and keep the peas tender and succulent.

Eat straight from the garden raw, or cooked with salads, rice or any meat or fish.
