



Peas - Greenfeast

Greenfeast peas, originally bred in England, are one of the sweetest peas available. It's easy to shell with 5-8 peas per 6cm length pod.

The peas can be eaten raw, but are also suitable for adding to soups, stews, curries and risottos.

Greenfeast is more tolerant to heat than most peas and keeps producing even as the weather warms up. Best grown in full sun, but can cope with very light shade.

Water deeply in the early morning, or late afternoon.

Apply slow release fertiliser when seedlings are 5-10cm tall. Apply liquid fertiliser when plants are fruiting or flowering.

The first peas can be picked 12-14 weeks after sowing.
