



Snow Peas

Given a sunny position and adequate water, snow peas will need little care. Good air flow is important, and a fortnightly dose of worm tea will give them a boost.

The soil needs to be kept moist, but be careful not to overwater.

Once the pea plants are about 60cm, you can begin picking the shoots. This will encourage side shoots. As soon as the peas are large enough to eat ... the smaller the sweeter ... pick them in the cool of the morning.

Once the crop has finished, chop up and dig in the plant as a green manure, or compost them.
