



# Tomato - Cherry Cocktail

Exceptionally sweet, very prolific with large trusses of fruit on vigorous plants.

Staking is recommended. Produces the best fruit in a free-draining soil with consistent moisture in a sunny position. Add lime and compost prior to planting. Protect from strong winds.

Fruit tastes its best when picked straight from the garden. Add a little olive oil and basil for an easy and tasty tomato salad.

To save the seed, scoop out pulp from ripe fruit and ferment for a day. Strain through a sieve, rinse with water. Thinly spread the seeds over paper towel, dry at room temperature, store for up to four years.
