



Tomato - Grosse Lisse

Grosse Lisse tomatoes grow on a robust vine that gets to about 150cm tall and, because the fruit can be quite heavy, requires a solid frame for the vine to grow on. Giving plants enough space is important to allow air flow which reduces the risk of disease. Choose a spot that gets at least 6 hours of sun each day and dig lots of compost and organic matter into the soil.

Water the plants every day so that the soil is always damp and as the tomatoes start to form apply a liquid fertiliser fortnightly. Apply potash during the growing season to support flower development, leading to more fruit.

The leaves of the tomato bush are not edible.
