



Zucchini Gold Rush

A compact, early fruiting cultivar which produces smooth skinned, golden yellow zucchini (also known as courgettes). Plant will produce fruits 15-20cm in length. The bright flowers are attractive to pollinating insects and can also be picked and used in cooking.

Feed the zucchini plant every 14 days with a potash rich fertiliser. Keep well watered but do not wet the fruit.

Pick fruit regularly to prolong cropping when they are about 7cm long. The flowers can be picked before this.

Tastes great served raw with dips or fresh in salads. Delicious when steamed or stir-fried. Wonderful when wrapped in foil and roasted on the grill, or added to a quiche or frittata.
