



Billy Buttons

Billy Buttons is a perennial plant that grows year around, and grow best in full sun or part shade. The plant needs a well drained soil enriched with plenty of organic matter.

They may need watering during the growing season, but avoid watering the leaves of the plant to avoid fungal diseases.

When the seedings are 5-10cm tall, apply a slow release fertiliser. When the plants flower, use a liquid fertiliser fortnightly.

The flowers should appear in 90-100 days.

Deadhead the flowers during the growing season, and when the plant is finished flowering, cut it back to neaten the appearance and encourage strong new growth. The plant may die back in cold weather.
