



Tomato Tropic

Choose a growing site that receives full sun, and add organic fertiliser, worm castings, or well rotted manure to the soil prior to planting. Tropic is an indeterminate varied that grows as a vine which will need staking to support the weight of the fruit and keep the plant off the ground.

Water tomatoes evenly and regularly to prevent fruit from cracking, splitting or rotting.

Avoid watering the leaves to prevent fungal diseases and trim off a few of the lower leaves to prevent water splashing on them.

Can be eaten raw or cooked, great with eggs for breakfast, or in salads, pizza or pasta.
